





We have the pleasure to inform you that the 2nd Congress "Evolution and Cancer: Cancer across Life" will be held at Vlatadon Monastery, in Thessaloniki/Greece, from June 29th till July 1st 2017.

The congress is organized by the **Gastro-Intestinal Cancer Study Group**, under the auspices of the **Hellenic Society of Medical Oncology** and the City of Thessaloniki.

The 1st Congress "End of life in cancer: The shiver of borders" was held at the Theological School of Halki, on June 2015.

The choice of that particular venue was not random. Our effort was to promote its symbolic character as a beacon of spirituality and education as well as a center eligible for organizing high level scientific meetings.

Aiming at the quest for our personal cast, with moderation, clarity and contemplation, the Theological School of Halki was once more our choice as a venue for the 2nd Congress "Cancer and Evolution: Cancer across Life".

However, due to the current unstable political status in Turkey, we have decided to place it in Greek territory, in Vlatadon Monastery in Thessaloniki.

The topics of the 2nd Congress will include evolution in treatment (surgery, drugs and radiotherapy), supportive care, reconstruction, diagnostic methods, prevention, quality of life, and genetics. Also the changing approach of the society, the advocacy groups, religions and financial authorities.

The evolution will highlight the future concept of cancer based on the past experience, the present knowledge and the trend of the research.
